Case Report Requirements

Case reports must clearly define the aspect of visual performance that will be assessed and trained. Some metric of success must be pre-identified and measured at the end. Summary of results and discussion will be necessary to conclude the case report. The report must be of publishable quality.

Required Format for Case Report:

1. Title
2. Summary
 - Up to 150 words summarizing case and outcome
3. Background
 - Why is this case important?
4. Case Presentation
 - How did the patient/athlete present and what was done?
5. Investigations
 - Research that was done to justify treatment/training
6. Differential diagnosis/training
 - What else can be done or trained
7. Treatment/Training
 - Detail what was trained and how/why
8. Outcome and Follow up
 - What was achieved and what follow up was done/planned
9. Discussion
 - Compare your results to others that have been published.

10. Learning points and take-home message

- What should the reader remember about this case?

11. References

12. Patient/Athletes perspective (optional but recommended)

- This will show what the patient/athletes experienced from their perspective.
